

Wildlife Management 5-Year Plan Requirements

A wildlife management 5-year plan for Medina Central Appraisal District (MCAD) must include:

1. Landowner's name and Property ID(s) as they appear on MCAD records
2. Landowner's signature, date signed, and contact phone number
3. Map identifying key locations of activities being practiced (or to be implemented)
4. Landowner's goals and objectives for the property
 - What is already done – what do you plan to do next – 5-year goals to accomplish
 - Specific management practices to be implemented
 - How will you implement your chosen activities (when and how often)
 - How will activities benefit native wildlife and their habitats
 - How much will be done, or acreage affected (intensity)
 - Specific native wildlife species targeted for management
 - What wildlife is currently there and what you want to accomplish
5. Documentation of work already accomplished
 - Records on courses attended pertaining to wildlife management (if applicable)
 - Original photos are accepted but photocopied photos are preferred – photos should be:
 - **Labeled** (indicate which activity is being practiced)
 - **Date-stamped** (at the time photo was taken)
 - **A visual timeline** of activities practiced throughout the year

 - More than one photo can be copied on a page
 - A maximum of 5 copies of photos documenting each activity are needed
 - A maximum of 5 copies of game camera photos are accepted

PLEASE NOTE:

- ❖ A 1-d-1 Open-Space Application must be filed with a 5-year plan
- ❖ Do not put plans in a binder – the plans are removed from the binder for scanning
- ❖ USB thumb drives cannot be accepted
- ❖ MCAD cannot accept plans via e-mail
